## **Preface**

The Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority provides educational services to the young generation of the country, preparing them for the labor market. The authority offers specialized and expert training to students and learners through its educational centers, which have more than 74 fields.

However, individual challenges cannot be solved by merely describing the importance of Technical and Vocational Education. It requires collaborative efforts from the governmental and private sectors, considering policies, management, leadership, specialization, capacity, and involvement from both sectors.

According to Afghanistan's climate conditions, the country has the potential for renewable energy (solar energy, water energy, wind energy, geothermal, and biogas energy), and energy production is a basic need of today's society. In this regard, the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan and the private sector are responsible for jointly working to meet the country's electricity needs through renewable energy sources.

For this purpose, the Afghanistan Renewable Energy Union (AREU) was established in 2013 AD. This union aims to identify private companies and organize them to develop the private sector of renewable energy.

## **Based on this Agreement**

Referencing decision 22/11/1401 of the leadership meeting of the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority and Afghanistan Renewable Energy Union (AREU), this agreement is signed.

In this agreement, the following abbreviations and expressions mean:

1. Authority: means Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority
2. Union: means the Afghanistan Renewable Energy Union (AREU).

## **Goals:**

1. Grow and develop academic cooperation.
2. Use both sides' capacities and facilities.
3. Exchange vocational and academic experiences.
4. Hire graduates of renewable energy fields in their sector.

## **Applicable Area**

This agreement applies to TVET-A-related areas in the capital and provinces and members of the Afghanistan Renewable Energy Union (AREU).

## **Responsibilities of TVET-A**

Based on this agreement, TVET-A is responsible for the following:

1. Plan advertisements about (AREU) at the related cultural display.
2. Plan academic activities for union members during extra hours in educational centers.
3. Provide opportunities for those 12th-grade graduates introduced by the union to educational centers.
4. Introduce students to the union for practical work.
5. Introduce graduates to the union for jobs.
6. Plan short-term vocational courses in the renewable energy section.
7. Assist the union in holding national and international conferences in the renewable energy section.

## **Responsibilities of Afghanistan Renewable Energy Union (AREU)**

1. Hire graduates of renewable energy graduates at related companies of the union based on companies' facilities.
2. Provide opportunities for practical work and internships for students and learners of TVET-A at companies and projects related to the union considering their fields.
3. Support in identifying educational standards and analyzing the market for renewable energy.

4. The union must support educational centers by equipping them with renewable energy materials.
5. Share technical experiences with educational centers in renewable energy.
6. Support educational centers to develop the fields of geothermal and biogas.
7. Help hold vocational courses in union companies.
